

med teachers such as Orhan Cem Çetin, Merih Akoğul and İzzet Keribar. I learned photoshop techniques on top. Since the early 2000s, I have been taking pictures, traveling the world and learning new things and continuing to develop myself.

You have had personal exhibitions to date. Even your works that have participated in Contemporary Istanbul. What was your happiest work / success? Did you participate in competitions?

After opening my first exhibition 'Hidden Subject Im, I joined Contemporary Istanbul twice. At the first fair, I had a work called 'Captive Market an consisting of 3 photographs. I love my work; it was a theme opposed to



the fact that women's identities were presented to men by society as a set of functions, particularly sensual pleasure.

What made me happy was the sale of my favorite photo.

Last year I participated in a photo exhibition in Paris, and even one of my photos adorns a French woman's room.

I also participated in competitions. I have degrees in many competitions.

Who are your favorite photographers from the world and our country?

I like Drew Tal, Uwe Ommer, Steve McCurry, Sally Mann, Annie Leibovitz, Marius Sperlich. And of course the pride of our country, world-wide artists such as Ara Güler, İzzet Keribar are at the top of my list.

We don't see plain, plain frames in your photos. Usually collage and photoshop







skills dominate. Even in the mood of most an oil painting table. What kind of expansion does this have in your soul?

With the acceleration in the digital world, we've all been able to shoot straight frames. Innovation is hard to find, to be different. Everybody's looking for something new.

In this quest, I began to make my stories overlapping in collage form, after a few attempts the system sat down. Yes, since I used to paint, I know the perspective and color. For example, I have paintings on some of my photographs and some works like foil.





What are your inspirations when you take photographs and make your works? How do you decide on a project?

Sometimes a word, an image, a state of emotion excites me, then I immediately start a preliminary investigation. Then I take pictures. I like the abandoned, run-down buildings. I took photos of my üş Dream World 'series in several places and abandoned buildings in different cities. I went to some buildings with

special permission. Then, with collage and photoshop techniques, I combined my own childhood, youth, experiences and emotions with frames reminiscent of my feelings. On average, it takes 1-2 years for a theme to come to an end. I'm preparing articles on the latest topic.

A selection of your works from the last 5 years will be exhibited at the 44A Art Gallery in Teşvikiye from 14 June to 14



July. What works are here? Can you tell us a bit about the contents? Why did you want to make such a selection?

I've had exhibitions on individual themes before, you know. This time I wanted to present some of my last 5 years of work together. That's why we called it ki selection "instead of the exhibition. We have brought together some works from my 'Secret Subject' and 'My Dream World'

exhibitions that I have exhibited in previous years. Not only did we create a pleasant opportunity for those who missed my other exhibitions, but it also gave me morale and motivation for the big global project I'm preparing for the new season.

'My Dream World', along with his writings, expresses my emotions, past memories and dreams in the future. What I tried to emphasize in







the 'Hidden Subject' series is 19. It was in fact a rebellion against Orientalism, which was created in the 19th century with a male-dominated view. Describes the woman's inexhaustible power and passion. By rejecting the place where the male-dominated view wanted to put the woman, I tried to move that subject, the woman, hidden in the entire orientalist world, to the point

where it belongs, to the very center of life. What are you planning for the coming days? What does Ceylan Atuk want to do in the future? I have a project that I have been working on for the last year, and I am focused on finishing it this year. It is not possible to plan for the future, I love living today. I will continue to walk and learn as much as possible.



What if we finally asked you to talk about your project? This will be a meaningful project that you will refer to global problems?

Yeah, as you know, we have a lot of global problems. In my opinion, I will address the most important issue of climate change. If global warming is not taken all over the world right now, in a very short time many living species will disappear, millions of people will

die of drought, starvation and disease. Why do we ignore this fact? In fact, we have the technology to solve the problem relatively, or let's say, alleviate it, but neoliberal governments do nothing about it! It doesn't look like it. In order to close the fossil fuel era that caused global climate change and to boğ not drown in our own unresolved issues is, it is up to us and sensitive societies. If we want to leave







a beautiful heritage to our children; Let's be eco-friendly, use bicycles, pay attention to recycling, plant trees, preserve natural resources, feed locally, use deodorants, perfumes, and waste water that is the blood of the world. Let's take care of our future! Briefly; to my audience: işler Can you see the future? How sensitive are you in this new Earth?

Ask them to look for the answer in themselves. Of course. an individual, a little effort mine ... But the project is large. I believe that you will also receive support from the corporate world and reach out to more people. I have meetings with sponsoring companies and I hope that if we can agree, I will have the effect I hope.

Could you briefly talk about yourself? How did you turn to architecture and build URBANIOBS?

I studied interior design at the university and did my master's degree on public space design at La Sapienza University in Rome. When I worked on product design and interior design in various offices and reali-





zed that I had reached the design maturity I needed, I founded URBANJOBS.

You sign interior projects in different typologies and scales. In addition to cafe and restaurant designs, there is also a management office where you imply interior design. What does working with different typologies give you?

We are able to de-

sign and project from 30 m2 area to 2.000 m2 area on project basis. In addition to functions and demands, we are working extensively on both detail and general ambience. We have our own details and we try to carry them further by updating them in every project. Working in different typologies not only provides the diversity between our designs but also brings diffe-





rent approaches such as using our point detail in one place as a shell, perhaps in another project. On the other hand, we think that different scales provide diversity and not being channeled to a single area keeps our minds vigorous in terms of design.

Do you have any principles in any concept and scale that express you behind your designs and say that you will never give up? How would you define your design philosophy?

Our approach to design consists of function, strength, beauty and emotion. We know that these elements make good design. While creating detail and ambience beauty and emotion, we need to pay attention to employer brief and end user











needs between these two poles that complement each other. At this point, stability and functionality are our two essential rules. We try to create our designs with all these components in mind.

Batard Bomonti is one of the most popular places in the region. Thanks to its distinctive design, stylish spirit and bohemian style, it stands out easily. Can we listen to the design process from you?

The starting point of the design was to bring the hissi feeling of experience "to the forefront with a simple elegance. Batard Bomonti, which does not give the feeling of a new building when it is entered, is designed as a space that has existed for years, and the necessity of a modern space containing French influences is also considered in the design process. By analyzing the customer profile and identifying the people residing in that region;



It is aimed to be a local pub where people can come and have fun and spend time. The element that determines the character of the design is the motto of olm designs being completely original en adopted by URBANJOBS. In the interior design, where a bohemian, but elegant look is also aimed within the

bohemian, it was our

priority to plan large

shelving units and details in a way that attracted the interest of people interested in design.

Bringing an innovative and flexible approach to adapt to different usage scenarios in the Bring Management Office, 'Village Square' is remarkable. Can you tell us about the design process? We started out by visiting a portion of





the firm's 70 existing warehouses, observing the entire process from the first receipt of the order to delivery, starting with a space design that will demonstrate the young, dynamic and strong stance of Bring, where employees, potential employees and collaborators who will visit the office will be impressed.

Within the open office system structure that adapts to different usage scenarios, a fast, dynamic and motivational fiction was planned in which the employees and founders are together in the area where all details from seating and storage units to plantings, from lighting design to sound system are handled with an innovative and flexible approach. In the 110 m₂ section of the area, special usage areas were obtained through platforms created by creating elevation differences on the ground. Thus, a party area was created which can be worked during working hours, which can be transformed into a pre-







sentation area where chairs can be set up by opening the projection screen during the presentations and removing the sofas, performing pilates sessions and concert events during work hours, and turning into happy party invitations on Fridays.

You also have product designs that are designed separately for your indoor projects.

As URBANJOBS, do you have a goal to advance in furniture design?

We design products for indoor projects as well as different products. We also update most products specific to that project and make small material, color and texture changes. We are very serious about product design. A chair design can sometimes take three months, and a couch can sometimes take six months. The reason for this is that we are thinking about the details and we are making design development in this process.

What inspires you in your designs? How do you nurture your creativity?

First of all, we don't get "design inspiration üzerinden through



social media accounts like Pinterest Traveling and seeing is as much as necessary, but a simple answer to your question. Sometimes an insect. sometimes the form of a flower inspires me. But I'm fed up more than a movie. I try to perceive the objects, colors, patterns, and sometimes the aerial image of a beach that Lisee in the scenes as an abstract figure in my mind, and then I try to embody it. What we call creativity is actually abstraction, one of the first elements we learned in

design. Abstraction requires creativity, but good design is not just creativity. Especially if something has not yet come to life in our minds about a design, we can experience a very painful process. Personally, I do.

Can you tell us about your current projects and future goals? We are currently conducting seven projects. Five of them in Turkey. Due to our confidentiality

agreements, we have

two overseas projects

that we have not vet

announced.
